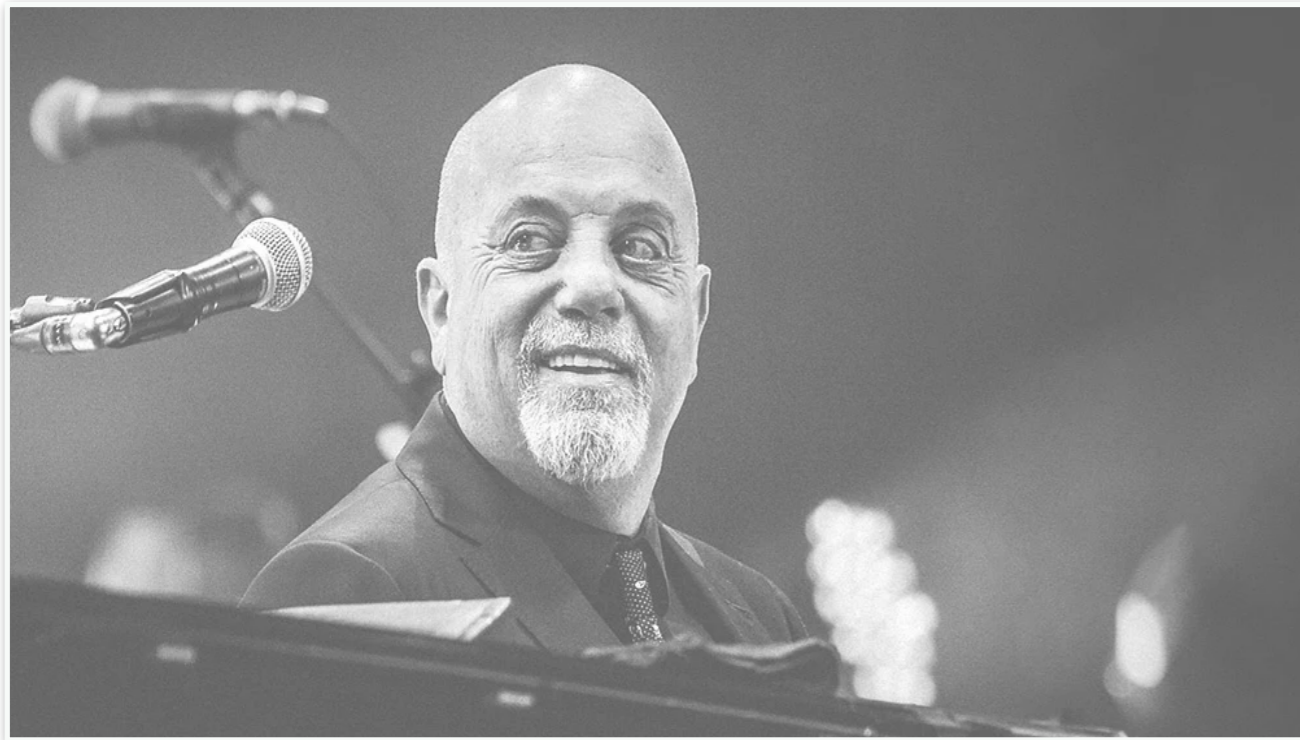

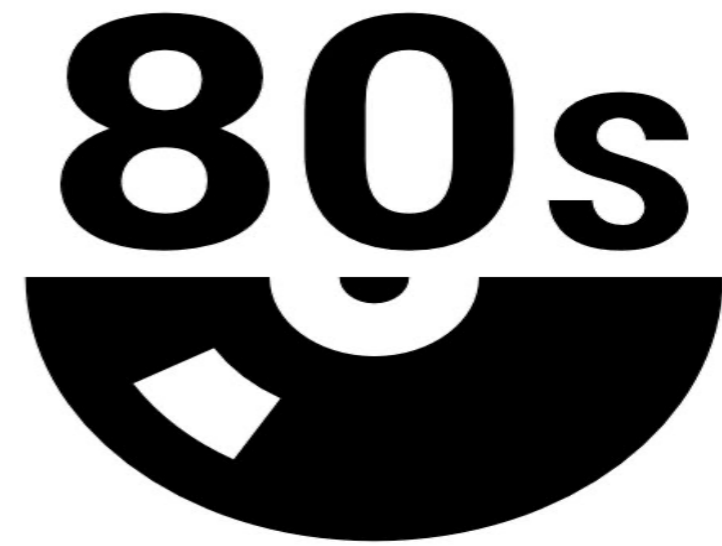

Battle of the Piano/Synth Bands

United Kingdom

Depeche Mode – synthpop/industrial icons

Pet Shop Boys – classic synthpop duo

David Gray – piano and acoustic-driven singer-songwriter

Elton John – The king of piano glam-pop and ballads

Paul McCartney – especially his solo work with rich piano tracks.

Kate Bush – avant-pop with piano roots

Human League – one of the earliest synthpop groups

Ultravox – synth-heavy new wave

Muse – progressive rock with epic piano and synth

Radiohead – especially in later albums ("Pyramid Song", etc.)

Germany

Alphaville – 1980s synthpop ("Forever Young")

France

Daft Punk – synth and vocoder-rich electronic

United States

Ben Folks – piano rock trio

Coldplay - heavy piano influence

The Fray– pop rock with piano as the lead

Steely Dan - complex jazz rock

Billy Joel – obviously! Master of piano rock

Jackson Browne – introspective piano-based songwriting

Bruce Hornsby and the Range – piano-fronted pop-rock with jazz/roots influences

Ireland

Hozier – though mostly guitar, some tracks feature heavy piano/gospel roots

Van Morrison – jazz and soul-infused piano compositions

Sweden

Eagle-Eye Cherry – occasional piano-pop tunes

Norway

A-Ha - famous for "Take on Me" and lush synth arrangements



🇬🇧 United Kingdom (The epicenter of prog/art rock)

Yes – complex compositions, piano/synth-heavy

Supertramp – piano-based progressive pop with philosophical lyrics

Roxy Music – glam/art rock with heavy synth and keys

Kate Bush – theatrical art pop with piano at the center

David Bowie – the master of theatrical personas (Ziggy Stardust, etc.)

Genesis (Peter Gabriel era) – costumes, storytelling, epic suites

The Who – pioneers of rock operas (Tommy, Quadrophenia)

Electric Light Orchestra (ELO) – orchestral glam rock with visual flair

Pink Floyd – conceptual, visual, dramatic (The Wall)

Jethro Tull – flute-led prog rock with narrative lyrics and costume

Muse – huge live shows, dystopian themes, synth and piano integration



🇺🇸 United States

Kansas – symphonic rock with keys and violin, epic arrangements

Styx – theatrical rock with piano and synth ballads

Toto – studio perfectionists, with prog-rock and pop fusion

🇨🇦 Canada

Rush – conceptual and sci-fi prog rock (2112, Hemispheres)

The Tea Party – mystical and theatrical with Eastern influences

🇦🇺 Australia

INXS (late era live shows) – flashy and dramatic

🇩🇪 Germany

Rammstein – industrial rock with fire, stunts, and full-blown theatre

🇸🇪 Sweden

Ghost – heavy rock with theatrical pope-like costumes and satanic satire

🇺🇸 United States

Meat Loaf – bombastic piano rock (Bat Out of Hell) written by Jim Steinman

KISS – glam rock + fire + stage personas

Todd Rundgren – prog/pop/art rock with theatrical flair

Blue Öyster Cult – mystique, conceptual themes, and visual stagecraft



 **United States**

Metallica (thrash metal)

Queensrÿche – Geoff Tate’s soaring voice and the band’s dramatic arrangements

Foreigner – riff-heavy, radio-friendly rock anthems and polished vocals.

Journey – arena-ready, piano-soaked power-ballads and stadium sing-alongs.

Toto – studio-musician supergroup blending rock chops with AOR polish.

Boston – multilayered guitar harmonies and soaring vocal production.

 **Canada**

April Wine – melodic hard rock with punchy riffs and tight harmonies.

Loverboy – upbeat, synth-tinged rock anthems full of call-and-response hooks.

Triumph – power-trio delivering arena-scale riffs and driving rhythms.

Streethart – keyboard-infused rock built on strong choruses and groove.

 **United Kingdom**

Bad Company – hard-rock supergroup formed by ex-Free members

Black Sabbath (pioneering heavy metal)

Ozzy Osbourne – Black Sabbath’s original vocalist turned solo heavy-metal icon, known for anthems like “Crazy Train.”

Judas Priest (classic heavy metal)

Iron Maiden (New Wave of British Heavy Metal)

Deep Purple (hard rock)

Def Leppard (glam/hard rock)

Scorpions (hard rock)

Rammstein (industrial metal)

Ghost (heavy/doom-influenced rock)

Europe – best known for “The Final Countdown,” they mixed synth hooks

AC/DC (hard rock)

The Eagles – smooth, harmony-rich country-rock anthems

Creedence Clearwater Revival – swampy, blues-inflected rock

Lynyrd Skynyrd – Southern rock icons known for triple-guitar leads

The Doors – dark, psychedelic rock

Boston – polished, multilayered guitar-rock stadium fillers

Aerosmith – swaggering blues-rock

The Doobie Brothers – groove-driven rock blending soul, R&B

Steely Dan – jazz-tinged studio perfectionists with cryptic, urbane lyrics

Journey – emotive, arena-ready rock

 **United Kingdom**

The Beatles – genre-defining pop-rock innovators

Eric Clapton - Renowned English guitarist and singer-songwriter whose soulful blues-rock style has defined generations

The Rolling Stones – raw, blues-based rock

Led Zeppelin – heavy, riff-driven pioneers who fused blues, folk

The Who – explosive, mod-influenced rock known for rock-opera

Pink Floyd – atmospheric, concept-album trailblazers

Queen – theatrical, genre-hopping

Cream – power trio melding blues improvisation with psychedelic intensity



 **Canada**

The Guess Who – eclectic rockers blending pop hooks with social commentary

Bachman–Turner Overdrive – boogie-rock specialists famed for driving riffs (“Takin’ Care of Business”)

April Wine – melodic hard-rockers balancing power chords and harmonies.

Rush – technically virtuosic trio melding prog complexity with hard-rock power

 **Australia**

AC/DC – stripped-down, riff-heavy rock legends with Angus Young’s signature guitar style

Little River Band – smooth, harmony-soaked soft-rock staples of FM radio

Cold Chisel – storytelling hard-rock grounded in Australian working-class life

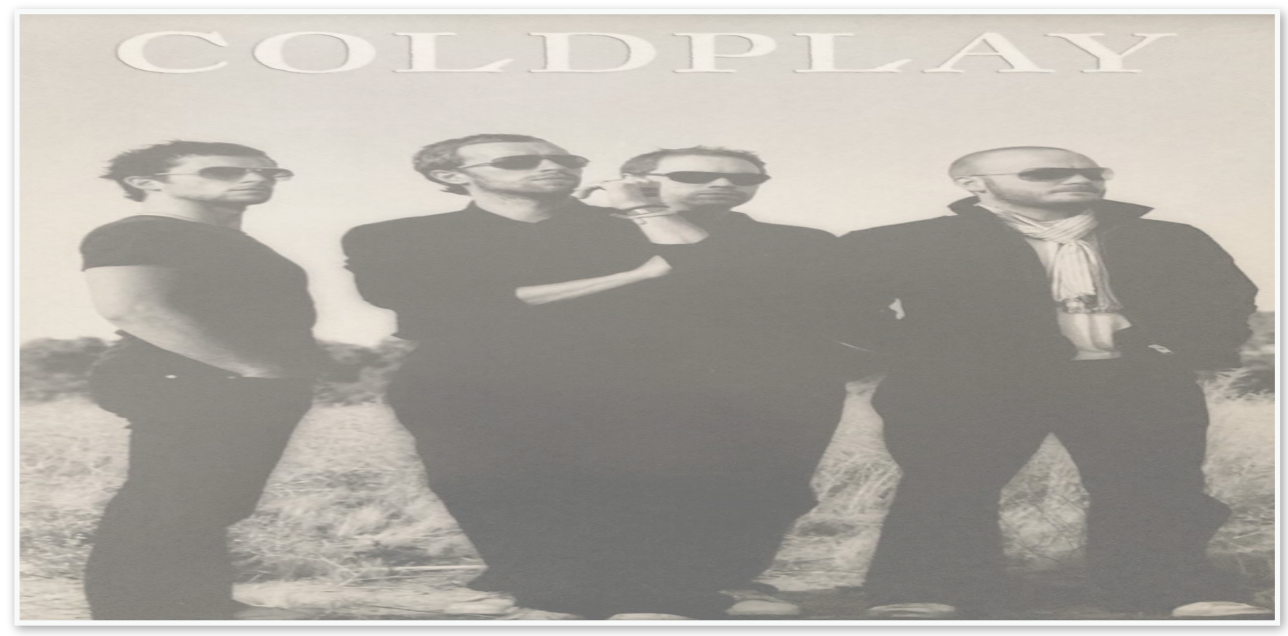
